Camp Rules

The Primary Concern of the Camp Staff is that each person has a week of spiritual growth and refreshment in a safe, supervised environment and healthy fellowship. A Happy Godly environment will be maintained.

- We discourage cliques and encourage making new friends.
- Camp Counselors will be monitoring all activity and must be respected. A Godly attitude will be greatly appreciated.
- No boy-girl flirting or pairing off will be allowed.
- Courting Couples must obtain special instructions from Camp Leaders on First Day of Camp and give parental contacts.
- Modesty in Dress (that covers and conceals the form of the body) and Modesty in Conduct will be expected and taught: Church Clothes and Play Clothes should follow the same rules of modesty.
- Ladies are asked to wear a loose-fitting dress or skirt (half-calf to ankle length without slits) with a loose-fitting second layer as w/ a Jumper, cape dress, vest, etc.
- Ladies are asked to wear their hair up with a head covering.
- Men should wear modest dress pants with button up shirts for Services; but loose fitting Jeans are allowed for Recreation. No T-shirts, no shorts, no hats with worldly advertisements or such like.
- For Youth: Cell phones may not be used except for emergencies or with permission. This includes all social media activity.
